About The Conference

Public transportation is notoriously unsafe for women, children, people living with disabilities and other vulnerable groups. We believe that by supporting more women to pursue careers in transport at every level, we can create safer, more accessible transport systems for everyone. Together, we must increase the visibility of women in the male dominated field of public transportation to reflect a more equitable and sustainable public transport system for everyone!

The Women and Transport Africa Conference celebrates its fifth year alongside Flone's 10th Anniversary in Nairobi, Kenya. This hybrid conference seeks to spotlight new research interventions and trends in inclusive mobility across the African continent. The conference will deep dive into the experiences of women, girls and other marginalised groups; sharing best practices, and providing networking opportunities to stakeholders. This conference will bring together change-makers such as gender and youth advocates, leaders and pioneers from research, practitioners, government, and the nonprofit sector to move forward specific and tangible ideas towards action.

The Building Feminist Cities event series is an initiative launched by Women Mobilize Women (WMW) and Safetipin to foster a global movement for resilient, feminist transport systems. After successful workshops in Philippines, Manila in 2024, and Brasilia, the series now partners with the Flone Initiative to host the series in Nairobi, Kenya.

The Flone Initiative's collaboration with Women Mobilize Women marks a significant step towards our shared vision of empowering women and promoting gender equity and inclusion in transportation and urban planning.

The objectives of the conference are:


- To raise awareness about challenges women, girls and other marginalized groups face in urban environments and transportation systems;

GETTING TO NAIROBI, KENYA







Airports

There are two airport options available if you will be flying in for the conference:

- Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. This is the main airport in Nairobi, located just outside of the city, along Mombasa Road.
 JKIA is the flagship airport of the Kenya Airports Authority (KAA). The airport hosts over 40 passenger airlines and 25 cargo
 airlines. It is Kenya's largest aviation facility, and the busiest airport in East Africa. JKIA is also the HQ of Kenya's main airline,
 Kenya Airways. (15 km from city centre)
- 2. Wilson Airport. This is a much smaller airport that mainly caters to regional travel to/from East and Central Africa. It is located along Langata Rd. Domestic flights constitute 90% of the total flights from the Airport with international flights accounting for 10%. The Airport is a fast and convenient gateway from Nairobi into Kenya's magical interior lands. Destinations served include Maasai Mara, Mombasa, Amboseli, Lamu, Kilimanjaro Diani, Lokichogio and Nanyuki. (6 km from city centre)

Visa and Vaccine Information

For information regarding country-specific visa requirements (including countries which are exempt) please refer to: https://immigration.ecitizen.go.ke/index.php?id=6. Generally, a citizen of a foreign country wishing to enter The Republic of Kenya must first obtain an e-Visa via http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html. A single entry visa costs approximately USD 51.

Please note that passport holders of the following countries CANNOT make e-Visa applications online. They will require Referred Visas. The visa applications are referred to the Director of Immigration services for processing and approval: Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Cameroon, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Formerly North Korea), Eritrea, Iraq, Kosovo, Lebanon, Libya, Mali, Palestine, Senegal, Somalia, Syria, Tajikistan and Yemen. Please contact your local Kenyan High Commission for more information regarding Referred Visas.

If needed, we are willing to provide a letter of invitation or of confirmation of registration for the purpose of the visa application. Please contact us through witconference@floneinitiative.org to arrange this.

All travellers are required to have a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate in order to gain entry to Kenya. Vaccinations against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Poliomyelitis for children and Hepatitis A and Typhoid for adults are recommended. Although Nairobi is considered safe, those travelling outside of the capital are advised to bring along anti-malarial medication. In summary, you will be asked to show the following on arrival (depending on your circumstances):

- 1. A passport valid for at least 6 months
- 2. eVisa printout from www.eCitizen.go.ke
- 3. Travel itinerary
- 4. Supporting letter e.g. letter from company or invitation letter from conference
- 5. Hotel booking confirmation letter
- 6. A valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate

Plastic Bag Ban


On 28th August 2017, the Kenyan government imposed a ban on the use, manufacture and importation of all plastic bags for commercial and household packaging. While this is fantastic for our natural environment, we understand that it may pose some challenges at customs for those travelling from countries with no such ban. Please avoid packing your belongings using plastic bags to avoid delays at the airport. It is unlikely that it will be strictly enforced (you might have to throw away the plastic bags at the airport), but take note just in case.











WHILE IN NAIROBI







Getting Around

The venue Nairobi Safari Park is located along Thika Road, easily accessible from most parts of the city. Public transportation options to the venue can be found on <u>Google Maps</u>. Buses are available from major bus stops including Odeon on Tom Mboya Street in Nairobi Central Business District.

Public transport facilities to/from the airport are limited, so taxi transfers are recommended. Airport transfers, provided by airport based taxis, may generally cost between KES1000 - KES3000 (\$7-\$25) depending on traffic conditions and your destination.

Ride share apps such as Uber, Bolt and LittleCab are also available. For the brave-hearted, public service motorcycles are a popular option for getting around Nairobi. Ride share apps such as Uber or Bolt will allow you to request a motorcycle pick-up from most locations.

Unless otherwise informed, conference attendees are expected to cater the cost of their own local transport and airport transfers.

Kenyan Currency

The official currency of the Republic of Kenya is the Kenyan Shilling (KES). Forex exchange services are available at the airport and all over the city. The following are the exchange rates with other common currencies for reference, as of 16th October 2024¹:

1 USD = 129.00 KES 1 EUR = 140.58 KES 1 GBP = 168.60 KES

There are ATM machines at the airport and at all banks. Most establishments (including taxis) accept either cash or mobile money payments (M-Pesa, Airtel Money). Credit cards are accepted at supermarkets and hotels, but only at some restaurants.

Language

English and Swahili are the official languages of the Republic of Kenya. Swahili is also the national language. Although Swahili is more widely spoken, most Kenyans living in Nairobi (especially staff at hotels and restaurants) have a conversational understanding of English. The conference will be held in English. There will be sign language interpreters present on Day 1, Day 2 and Day 3 for all the main sessions.

Weather

In December, Nairobi typically experiences warm and pleasant weather. Daily temperatures are likely to average around 25°C (high) and 15°C (low). Though the chance of rain is lower, it's still advisable to be prepared for occasional showers during the conference.

Electrical Compatibility










In Kenya the standard voltage is 240 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. You can use your electric appliances in Kenya, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 220 - 240 V (as is in the UK, Europe, Australia and most of Asia and Africa). The power sockets are type G.









Accommodation Options

Unless otherwise informed, it is the responsibility of conference attendees to arrange their own accommodation. For key- note speakers whose accommodation will be catered for by the conference, extras such as phone calls and use of the minibar need to be covered at your own expense.
